Admissions Procedures

- To apply for admission, complete all the documents in the application packet and return it to
 the school office with the non-refundable application fee of \$50.00. When the application and
 fee are received, you will be notified by mail or telephone about your in-class observation
 and/or shadow day.
- 2. Please have a copy of your child's birth certificate, last report card and immunization records attached to your application packet.
- 3. Once all documents are received and your in-class observation and family interviews are completed, the Admissions Committee will evaluate your child for placement.
- 4. Parents will be notified via email of the Admissions Committee's decision.
- 5. For late spring and summer applicants, testing and an interview will be arranged individually if class space is available.
- 6. New Medina has a rolling admissions policy, whereby applicants may be admitted during the year if an opening occurs.
- 7. It is the policy of the school not to deny admission on the basis of race, creed, national origin, sex or economic or social status. The school will seek students of diverse backgrounds in the belief that they bring something to be valued and respected, and because New Medina wants to be broadly inclusive in the community we serve.
- 8. If a student's application is pending for a class that is full, the application will be placed in a waiting pool. The pool of applicants is considered for openings with due regard for the current population of the class. If a space becomes available, the Admissions Committee reviews all waiting pool applications.
- 9. A child is enrolled for the entire school year. If a child is withdrawn from the school anytime during the academic year, any unpaid portion of the year's tuition will be the responsibility of the parents.
